Dr. Catherine Montgomery

Catherine Montgomery is Reader in Education and Director of Postgraduate Research in the Faculty of Education at the University of Hull. Catherine's research interests centre on intercultural education, internationalisation of the curriculum and assessment in higher education. She has published widely in this field including the book 'Understanding the international student experience' published by Palgrave Macmillan in

2010 and her book co-authored with Val Clifford 'Moving towards internationalisation of the curriculum for global citizenship in Higher Education, which came out in 2011. Catherine was previously the Research Director for the Centre for Excellence in Teaching and Learning at Northumbria University where she led a research team focusing on the impact of innovative assessment in Higher Education. The work of the CETL at Northumbria culminated in a book co-authored with Kay Sambell and Liz McDowell, 'Assessment for Learning in Higher Education' which came out in 2013. Catherine was awarded a National Teaching Fellowship in 2010 in recognition of her contribution to internationalisation in Higher Education and her innovative teaching and learning in diverse student groups.
