Laura Middleton-Green is a Marie Curie Clinical Academic Research Fellow in End-of-Life Care in the Faculty of Health Studies, University of Bradford. She has a background as a Clinical Nurse Specialist in Palliative Care, and has worked as an educator and lecturer in hospice and University. Recent research includes a qualitative evaluation of a telemedicine service to support people in the last year of life and their carers, hospice nurses' views of single nurse administration of controlled drugs, and doctoral research undertaking observation of dying older people in an acute hospital. She helped establish "Let's Talk Death", a group of staff and students at the University, with the aim of creating opportunities for conversations about death and dying within the local community. The group have organised and facilitated a variety of events including Death Café, conferences, seminars and discussion groups. She is passionate about dispelling myths about death and dying, getting people talking, compassionate communities and reflective practice.
