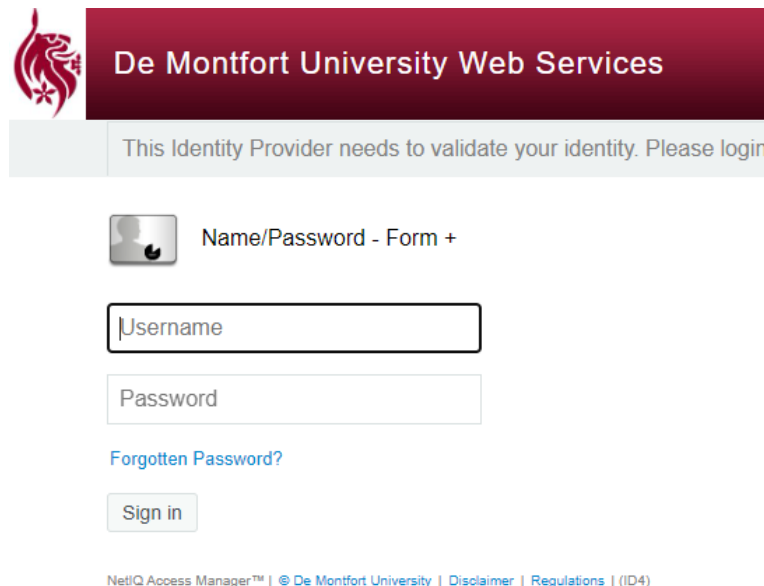

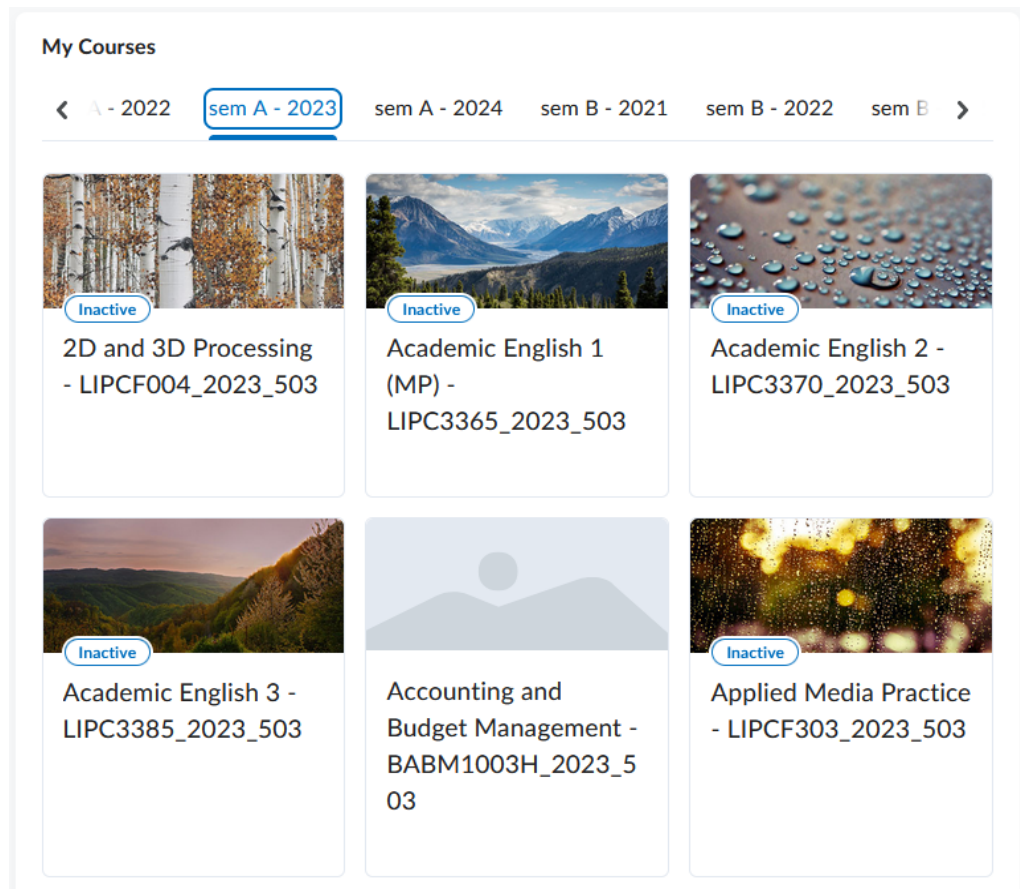


Figure 2 Example My Courses widget showing enrolled shells
