



## **Assessments IYZ Students**

We have now reviewed our approach to assessments to make sure it is fair, flexible and leaves no student disadvantaged.

### ***General Principles for IYZ Term 2 Assessments – DMU Dubai***

1. Where possible, all Term 2 assessments will be submitted or taken as intended and in line with the approved module specification.
2. All students with coursework submissions due in Term 2 will automatically be given a deadline extension of five working days with no formal deadline extension request required.

***\*Please note we have already extended your submission deadlines for EAP1, EAP2 and Academic and Study Skills.***

3. Where exams or practical assessments cannot be delivered as intended, these assessments will either be moved online (where practicable), be delivered via an alternative assessment method, or be deferred to the next available opportunity.

***\*Please note we will update you accordingly regarding the final two exams of TMSS100D Maths Study Skills.***

4. If students feel unable to submit their coursework within the five working day extension period or feel unable to engage with a scheduled exam or practical assessment, they may request to defer the assessment to the next available opportunity. No formal application will be required but **students will be required to inform the University of their intention to defer. (Uncapped)**
5. If students' Term 2 assessments are deferred, the University will make every effort to ensure that students are able to complete their deferred assessments in a timely manner.

### ***General Principles for IYZ Term 1 October Cohort Resits – DMU Dubai***

#### ***1. Submission deadlines for reassessments will be as follows:***

- Friday 27th March 12:00PM



2. Where exams or practical reassessments cannot be delivered as intended, these reassessments will either be moved online (where practicable), be delivered via an alternative assessment method, or be deferred to the next available opportunity.
3. If students feel unable to submit or engage with their reassessment, they may request to defer the reassessment to the next available opportunity. No formal application will be required but students will be required to inform the University of their intention to defer.
4. If students' Term 1 reassessments are deferred, the University will make every effort to ensure that students are able to complete their deferred reassessments in a timely manner.
