Location

The ceremony will take place at Taj Exotica Resort & Spa, The Palm, Dubai.

Valet parking will be available on the day and will be offered on a first-come first-served basis. There is also paid public parking on the same road as the hotel.



Registration

On arrival, you should proceed immediately to the Registration Desk to collect your name card and guest tickets.

Please note that the name card will be used to officially announce each graduands as they are called to the stage. It is therefore essential that you keep it safe at all times and ensure it is not misplaced.



Guest Tickets - Refund Policy

The university will only offer a refund for guest tickets in the following circumstances:

- Where the student is deemed ineligible to graduate due to pending academic results, including outstanding assessments or reassessments.
- We are notified in writing at studentadvicecentre.dubai@dmu.ac.uk by 5pm on 23 September 2025 that you are no longer able to attend due to above reason.

Refunds will not be available for:

- Guest tickets no longer required if the graduand is unable to graduate due to outstanding tuition fee debts to the university, or due to illness of either the student or guest(s).
- Students who require a visa to attend their ceremony and were not able to secure the visa in time to attend.



Academic Gown and Hood

Following registration, you will be directed to the robing room to collect your academic gown and hood.

Once you have collected this, you should proceed directly to the photographer or your allocated seat within the venue/ballroom.



Graduands are required to arrive 2 hours before the start of the ceremony for registration, and to collect their academic gown and hood.

All graduands must be seated no later than 15 minutes before the ceremony begins.

Parents and guests are kindly requested to arrive in good time and also be seated at least 15 minutes prior to the start of the ceremony.

Graduands are required to attend in accordance with their Programme as outlined in the schedule mentioned above.

Please be aware that doors to the venue will be closed at 15 minutes, prior to the start of the ceremony and will not re-open until the ceremony has concluded.

Latecomers (Graduands and/or parents, guests) will not be permitted to graduate or enter the venue/ballroom.



Photography

An external paid photographer will be stationed in the venue.

Graduands and their parents/guests are welcome to take their own photographs before, during, and after the ceremony.

Please note that only students who have hired gowns from the approved supplier, Caps & Gowns, will be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.

Students are required to wear the full DMU academic dress, which includes a gown, hood, and hat, from our approved academic dress supplier. Any student without the complete DMU academic dress will not be permitted.



Seating Arrangements

On arrival in the venue, you will be directed to your allocated seat. Please note graduands are called to the stage in the order of seating therefore you MUST be seated in the seat that has been allocated to you. If you are in any doubt, please check with a member of staff who will be stationed nearby.



Prior to the start of the Ceremony

Please can you ensure that you (and your parents/guests): - switch off your mobile phones or turn to silent - remain seated during the Ceremony (this includes children) - refrain from talking during the Ceremony - ensure that restless children are taken out of the venue, by the nearest exit, temporarily until they have a chance to calm/quieten down.



The Ceremony

Graduands will be called individually to have their degree conferred. At the appropriate time, staff will direct you to the stage, and you must present your name card to ensure you are formally announced.

It is very important that you proceed to your seat directly after receiving your degree certificate to ensure that you do not disrupt the ceremony for fellow graduates.
