Students studying on a course that is validated by DMU and taught by a partner are enrolled at both the University and the partner, therefore you can take advantage of the facilities and resources of both institutions. The qualification obtained at the end of the course is a DMU Higher Education Award.

Having been established for over 20 years, with over 1,500 students DMU's collaborative partnerships are mature and well developed. The students studying at our partners represent a significant student body within DMU. DMU and its partner colleges and institutions are highly experienced in teaching and supporting collaborative partnerships.
