













WHAT IS CRITICAL THINKING

CRITICAL THINKING VS. OPENING UP YOUR BRAIN HOLE


- Not necessarily involving discussion :

Dialogue with oneself - Nirvana


May not following a particular process :
 We are thinking all the time


-Can be just a thought Not necessarily involving induction/deduction Not necessarily be logical and reasoning Can be purely descriptive and fluid



Imagine there is law

HOW WE FACILITATE ALTERNATIVE CREATIONAL THINKING IN TEACHING ?

- Brainstorming: discussion and speak up
- Make use of multiple sources of information
- Always think why.

- Discussion and

. . .

- : 1/2 minute self-reflection individual task
- The power of thinking

Replace reasoning with questioning :
What have not been asked?
Why can we think about why now?
What are we asking when we asking why?
