

Higher and Degree Apprenticeships Additional Funding

Are there any additional funds to support apprentices?

There are several additional payments available to support apprentices. These funds are paid to De Montfort University who pass it down to employers.

How can I claim these funds for an apprenticeship?

In the initial eligibility checks for an apprentice, our Higher and Degree Apprenticeship Team will support the apprentice and employer to make sure they receive any additional funding to support their learning needs.
