Duties of the role	
<b>Overall purpose of the role</b>	Lead and provide academic expertise on urgent, emergency, paramedic and unscheduled care education to undergraduate students and post registration health professionals.
<b>Main duties and responsibilities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide modular leadership on specialist modules relating to emergency care and paramedicine practice and others as related to expertise.</li> <li>• Plan, deliver and evaluate classroom and clinical teaching sessions required for the training and education of students on paramedic and nursing modules and programmes.</li> <li>• Support students in their learning activities both in the academic setting and clinical setting within practice.</li> <li>• Develop and implement suitable assessment strategies for both theory and practice components.</li> <li>• Act as a resource for clinical staff in an identified clinical area by providing them with information on curricular changes and support and assist them in implementing those changes.</li> <li>• Actively contribute to research, external income generation, and international activities and developments within the division and school.</li> <li>• Maintain and develop skills and competencies required to sustain professional registration.</li> <li>• Assess own requirements for clinical updating and negotiate time to develop and maintain skills within a clinical setting.</li> <li>• Work as a member of a multi-professional academic and clinical team to develop inter-professional and cross faculty working.</li> <li>• Work as a member of the division, contributing fully to the development of education provision and health and social care initiatives within the school and the university.</li> <li>• Work as a team member within the practice areas; attend such meetings as is required to contribute to the development of practice.</li> <li>• Communicate and work across the different subject areas and wide ranging groups, contributing in a positive and facilitative manner to the development of education and training.</li> <li>• Perform any other duties commensurate with the job grade as reasonably required from time to time.</li> <li>• Treat all DMU staff, students, contractors and visitors with dignity and respect.</li> </ul>
