- A brief statement about your current role or position
- A short explanation of how attending the conference would benefit you, your research, or your professional development
- Any contextual information you feel is relevant (e.g., limited access to institutional funding)

How applications will be evaluated

We will prioritise applications that:

- Demonstrate a clear benefit from attending the conference
- Show that the fee waiver would meaningfully support access
- Fit within the overall aim of encouraging participation from a diverse range of researchers and practitioners

Decisions will be made by the organising team, and applicants will be notified shortly after the deadline.
